



ROLE OF THE BOARD OF MANAGEMENT – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

What does the Board of Management do?

The Board of Management provides the future direction and vision for the Counties Manukau Kindergarten Association (CMKA). It is about thinking about the longer-term issues and the 'big picture' aspects of early childhood education that impact our organisation.

What is the Board of Management responsible for?

- Ensuring high-quality early childhood education for children which is responsive to local community needs.
- The Board develops strategic goals to guide the future direction of the Association, and policy statements to guide the day-to-day management of the Association.
- Supporting the Chief Executive Officer in her/his management role, by providing the delegated authorities in administration, personnel and finance matters to allow the Chief Executive Officer to manage effectively.
- Reporting annually to the kindergarten membership of the Association.
- Adhering to a Code of Conduct.

When does the Board of Management meet?

The Board meets monthly, usually 11 times per year, in the evenings at CMKA Head Office in Takanini for approximately 2-3 hours. Board papers are sent to all board members before the meeting so that members are fully informed and any discussion can occur. Occasionally when we review or develop a new key strategy a working party or group may be formed which Board members can opt into.

Why should I become a Board Member?

You will have an opportunity to experience skills involved in governing a charitable organisation, including:

- Meeting participation and decision making
- Strategic Planning, Goals and Vision
- Development of Management Plans
- Policy and procedure development

Board members often use these new skills in other employment opportunities to further their careers and development.

Board members also receive a meeting fee to attend Board Meetings, a travel allowance, and an expense allowance for specific costs related to Board participation.
